ART ITEMS:

All displayed items must be original and made by the exhibitor. Manufactured jewelry, kits, mod ceramics, commercial displays, etc. are prohibited. If you made it, painted it, carved it, formed it, knitted or crocheted it, welded or soldered it, built it or significantly altered it, then bring it! Example: you can sell a manufactured shirt or hat only if you have painted it or made significant changes; no silk screening. Clothing or jewelry must have a website or pictures to show our Committee your creative process. Please call 305-852-5458 or text 305-395-9832, if you are in doubt. We reserve the right to expel any vendor that does not meet our criteria without refund.

REGISTRATION:

You can download an application form & view vendor space locations from our websites. Artist spaces are \$125 (includes tax) for a 10'x10 site. Price includes tax. Please fill out registration form in its entirety, sign the application and mail with registration fee payable to: **Art Under the Oaks. Mail to: P.O. Box 456, Tavernier, FL 33070.** All applications must be received by November 30, 2023 to be guaranteed a booth space for this year's event. An acceptance postcard or email will be mailed to you acknowledging receipt of payment and booth location & number. If spaces are available on the day of event, registration fee must be paid in CASH. Note: A temperature-controlled dining area inside the Church Hall with tables & chairs will be provided for vendors. Coffee, cookies or donuts will be available for free to all vendors on Friday afternoon and Saturday before 9:00 AM.

SET-UP TIME & CHECK IN:

Set-up will be on Friday, January 12 from 12 NOON to 6PM. Please check in at the registration desk inside Williams Hall before setting up. Artists may arrive at 6 AM Saturday however all booths MUST BE COMPLETELY SET UP by 8:00 AM and open for business by 9 AM on Saturday. Setting up and dismantling (not before 4PM) will be each vendor's responsibility. Exhibitors must set-up 1 foot away from concrete walkways to facilitate traffic flow through the exhibit area.

TEAR DOWN:

No tear down can begin before 4:00 PM. Please pack up all supplies and equipment prior to moving car into the vendor area. This will alleviate traffic issues and delays for other vendors.

SECURITY:

There is no security provided and overnight parking on the site (any vehicle) is prohibited

PARKING:

On the event day from 6 AM to 8 AM you may park closer to your exhibit to facilitate the set-up process. Your vehicle/trailers must be moved to the designated parking area by 8 AM in order to facilitate visitor traffic. Parking is PROHIBITED along US #1, the frontage road and the church access road. Traffic safety issues will be aggressively enforced by our local sheriffs office. Each vendor will be given one free parking pass for your vehicle and it must be displayed on your driver's side dash. Additional onsite parking passes can be purchased at the registration desk for \$5. Free parking will be available at Plantation Key Elementary, walking distance from the venue. During this event left turns are not permitted when exiting the church parking area, only right turns.

RAFFLE:

We would greatly appreciate a donation of your artwork to be exhibited and raffled during the show. Please label your art donation with your name & booth number and bring it to the raffle table after 9 AM or one of our committee members will visit your booth on Saturday morning.
