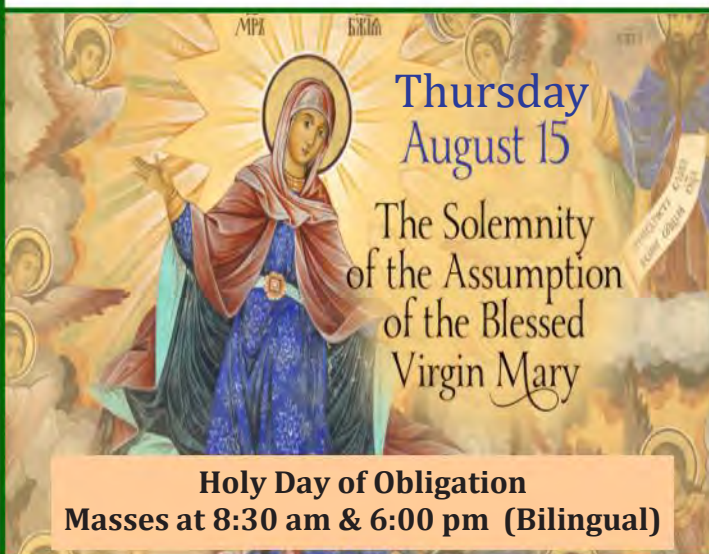

Chicken or Egg?

“Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.” (Mt 6:12) You could read that line as a warning that God only forgives those who forgive others. Paul reverses that conditional meaning to say that we forgive because God has already forgiven us. So which came first, the chicken or the egg?

In a sense, both are needed: Jesus died on the cross to show that God forgives sins you haven’t even committed yet. We have to want to be forgiven and accept that gift from God. And we also have to be willing to forgive those who have hurt us. There are many ways to do that.

One is to forgive in your heart. If it is someone you love, you know they didn’t mean to hurt you and so you don’t get angry at them. If you don’t love the one who hurt you, you still need to forgive, so you can let go of the hurt. (And be forgiven for not loving your neighbor!)

Paul also tells us to be kind and compassionate (Eph 4:32.) We can go to the next step after forgiving in our hearts: We show our forgiveness in our actions. A friend or relative might get a hug; others might get a handshake or words of forgiveness.

Jesus showed how much God wants to forgive us by his death on the cross. Because we are forgiven, we are then able to forgive others. So while God’s love and forgiveness are always first, we must be able to forgive others so that we can accept it from God.

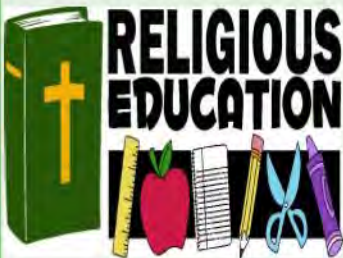
TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In 1794, a young Irishwoman befriended two widows aboard ship while emigrating to America. They bought a house in Philadelphia and began to live a community life under the direction of a priest. Soon they relocated to Washington. There, the “pious ladies,” as the neighbors called them, were asked by their priest friend, by then the president of Georgetown University, to begin a religious community. In 1799 they established a branch of the Visitation Order founded by Saint Jane de Chantal and Saint Francis de Sales in the 1620s.

The unique vision of this order followed a sensible routine, less arduous and more flexible than most traditions, and also accepted widows and older women. Amazingly, this American outpost of the Visitation began without reference to the “rule” of the Order. Most of the European convents had been lost under the “reign of terror,” and the rules and customs of the community could not be obtained. A copy of the rule was discovered in 1812, and in 1816 the pope officially established the monastery. By then, some French nuns had regrouped, and they sent a habit and cross to be copied. (No religious wore the habit in public in the United States until after the Civil War.) From the beginning, the Georgetown nuns had an educational mission, even though they discovered in the “rule” that such work was officially off-limits for the contemplative life. In America, the nuns depended on a school for their livelihood, so the rule was adapted. Today, the Academy of the Visitation is a thriving example of excellence in Catholic education, and the adjacent monastery is the oldest monastic foundation in the original thirteen United States.

FLORIDA IS PROTECTING LIFE Myth vs Fact

DON'T LET THE FEARMONGERS LIE TO YOU

MYTH: Women can no longer receive healthcare.

FACT: Florida does not restrict lifesaving care for women – it promotes it. Florida hospitals and health care providers deliver some of the highest quality prenatal care in the nation. Florida also provides additional maternal health care resources through the Florida Department of Health.

MYTH: Women will be jailed as a result of the law.

FACT: Florida's criminal abortion penalties do not apply to pregnant women. Florida works to ensure the health and safety of mothers and babies by continuing to hold medical providers accountable to the standards of their oath to protect and ensure the health and well-being of their patients.

MYTH: Women won't even know they're pregnant.

FACT: Pregnancy tests have evolved substantially over the years. Trace levels of hCG can now be detected as early as eight days after ovulation.

MYTH: Women will be forced to give birth even if their life or health is in jeopardy.

FACT: Florida law includes exceptions to save the pregnant woman's life or avert a serious risk of substantial and irreversible physical impairment of a major bodily function. Exceptions exist for pregnancies resulting from rape, incest, human trafficking, and for emergency medical procedures to save the life of the mother.

MYTH: Women in need of treatment for an ectopic pregnancy will not have access to care.

FACT: Treatment to remove an ectopic pregnancy is not prohibited under Florida law.

MYTH: Women who experience a premature rupture of membranes (PROM) will be sent home without care.

FACT: Florida law does not prohibit treatment for women who experience premature rupture of membranes (PROM) and as such, physicians in Florida should follow established standards of care regarding the most appropriate course of action for PROM. Florida law includes an exception to save the life of the mother or avert a serious risk of substantial and irreversible physical impairment of a major bodily function. In addition to this exception, the law does not prohibit saving the life of the mother in medical emergencies.

MYTH: Women who experience the tragic loss of a pregnancy, commonly known as a miscarriage, will be denied treatment.

FACT: Florida law does not prohibit the removal of the pregnancy for women who experience a miscarriage in any circumstance.

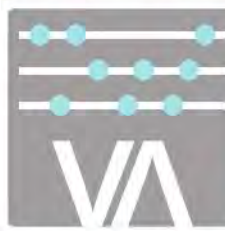
